The conference team are working to secure sponsorship for the event so please send us any leads that you may have. Sponsors get an opportunity to feature at this event and grow their impact in the sector.

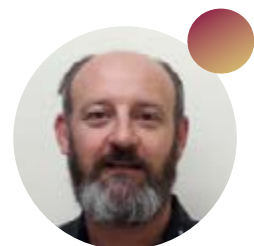
The next big milestone is the call for abstracts which will go out in March and the keynote speakers will be announced shortly after that.
